Day 1: Arrive Anchorage

Welcome to Alaska! Arrive into **Anchorage**, Alaska largest city located between the Chugach Mountains and the Cook Inlet. Meet your Tour Director and transfer to your hotel.

Day 2: Anchorage - Rail Journey - Denali National Park














Day 5: Seward - Glacier & Wildlife Cruise
