Day 1 – Depart the USA - Board your overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal.

Day 2 – Welcome to Lisbon - After arriving in Lisbon the day is yours to relax or begin exploring. This evening, gather with your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner and the start of your adventure.

Day 3 – Discover Lisbon - Set out on a guided tour of Lisbon's most iconic sights, including the Monument to the Discoveries, Belém Tower, and Jerónimos Monastery. This afternoon is free to shop, sample local cuisine, or soak up the atmosphere of this vibrant city at your own pace.

Day 4 – Lisbon to Porto via Fátima & Coimbra - Travel north through Portugal, stopping in Fátima, one of the world's most important Catholic pilgrimage sites, and Coimbra, home to one of Europe's oldest universities. Day 9 – Lamego & a Quintessential Douro Experience - Journey to the hilltop town of Lamego to visit the magnificent Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies, famous for its grand staircase and beautiful blue-and-white tilework. Later, savor a traditional lunch at Quinta da Pacheca, one of the Douro Valley's most celebrated wine estates, before returning to the ship for an evening of local entertainment.

Day 10 – Porto - Your cruise comes full circle as you return to Porto, a city of colorful riverside buildings, historic landmarks, and old-world charm. Enjoy a tour of the city's highlights, then spend the remainder of the day exploring, shopping, or simply soaking in the atmosphere at your leisure.

Day 11 – Return to the USA - Disembark your ship and transfer to the airport for your flight home, filled with memories of Portugal's historic cities, scenic vineyards, and the unforgettable beauty of the Douro River.
