- Spend two nights in Chicago & enjoy a narrated tour of “The Windy City”
- Enjoy a narrated Architectural cruise of Chicago
- Illinois Route 66 stops including the Old Joliet Prison, the Gemini Giant and the historic Ambler/Becker Texaco Station
- Tour the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum which documents the life of the nation’s 16th U.S. president

- Visit the Gateway Arch National Park including the Museum of Western Expansion, the Gateway Arch & narrated cruise along the Mississippi River
- Enjoy a tasty treat at Ted Drewes Frozen Custard and have dinner at Favazza’s on the Hill
- Tour the National Museum of Transportation and see its amazing collection of vehicles
- Missouri Route 66 attractions including Lone Elk Park and the Fanning 66 Outpost 42-foot tall Rocking Chair
- Visit Meramec Caverns filled with rare and colorful mineral formations
- Kansas Route 66 sites including the Kan-O-Tex Service Station, the Route 66 Visitors Center and the Marsh arch “Rainbow Bridge”
- Photo stops at the Blue Whale of Catoosa and Pops 66 landmark diner
- Enjoy a narrated tour of Oklahoma City, including the Oklahoma City National Memorial
