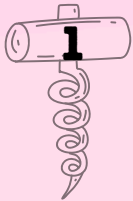

## ITINERARY

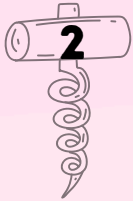
Day



Today we depart Phoenix and head towards the beautiful rolling hills of Temecula, California, the largest viticultural region in Southern California.

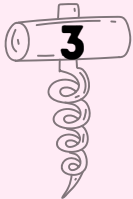

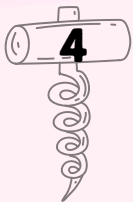
After an included breakfast at the hotel, depart for Carlsbad Flower Fields. Enjoy a relaxing open air tractor ride through 55-acres of blooming Giant Tecolote Ranunculus flowers! It's truly stunning!

From beautiful flowers we go to the lush citrus groves of Belle Marie Winery. Our wine tasting will take place in the elegant and expansive Barrel Room.

This afternoon, explore Old Town Temecula on your own. Join your fellow guests at the hotel for an evening reception, then continue exploring, or stay and relax.



Have a leisurely included breakfast before visiting another unique Temecula winery. Then it's on to Palm Springs for a night. This evening, enjoy the Palm Springs VillageFest, a lively pedestrian street fair on Palm Canyon Drive that features arts, crafts, food, and entertainment.



After an included breakfast, we head to the top of Mt. San Jacinto on The Palm Springs Aerial Tramway. Watch the scenery change as you travel over 2 ½ miles along the cliffs of Chino Canyon.
